Model United Nations Water and Sanitation Education (MUNWSE) is an educational simulation program focused on global water and sanitation issues. MUNWSE provides a unique platform for participants to engage with global water and sanitation challenges, develop solutions, and promote sustainable development. Model United Nations (MUN) is an academic simulation of the United Nations where students from around the world participate in conferences and debates to discuss global issues.

To provide global water and sanitation challenges and raise awareness on health and wellbeing, provide youth, students and young leaders to foster dialogue and debate on water and sanitation issues as well as encourage them to develop innovative solutions and policies.
